Paladin Security and the United Steelworkers Local 5296 are establishing a Multi-Workplace Joint Health and Safety Committee. Worksites in health care, commercial office, manufacturing among other site types require Health & Safety representatives for the committee.

Committee members will be required to do the following:

- Identify actual and potential hazards in the workplace;
- Obtain information from the employer relating to health and safety in the workplace;
- Inspect the workplace on a regular basis;
- Participate in any health and safety-related testing in the workplace;
- Recommend health and safety improvements in the workplace.

Designated Health and Safety Worker Representatives will be provided the necessary training to adequately perform the site inspections and complete health and safety reports.

All time spent by Committee members in connection with attending Committee meetings or performing duties prescribed by the Occupational Health and Safety Act will be considered as time at work. Committee members will be paid at the appropriate rate of pay, and duties will occur during regular work time. The Union will facilitate appropriate leaves to enable members to participate in required duties.

All Health and Safety Worker Representatives will be chosen by the Union. Any person(s) with prior health and safety experience are encouraged to apply.
